



Caring for Your
Fraser Fir Tree

Make a fresh cut.

Cutting straight across the base of the tree, remove one half inch before placing tree in stand.

Keep hydrated - check water often.

Use a stand that will hold a gallon of water or more. A tree may take up a gallon of water in the first 24 hours and a quart a day after that. No preservatives are needed.

Place away from heat sources,

including heating vents, radiators, wood stoves, fireplaces, and sunny windows.

Check light strings

for broken bulbs and frayed wiring.

Don't overload electric circuits.

Turn off lights

before going to bed or leaving home.

Remove tree promptly

from your home after Christmas and recycle it.
