Annuals have come a long way in the last decade to offer even more to love – wild color combinations, selfcleaning varieties eliminate deadheading, incredible flower power that attracts various pollinators, and brilliant foliage, and flowers for shady spots as well as sunny spaces.

Moving beyond just being planted in the ground, the evolution of *fancy* annuals have created a whole new facet of gardening known as "container gardening". *Fancy* annuals offer a wide variety of vivid colors and foliage's for both sun and shade. *Fancy* annuals are perfect for use in containers and can be combined with other foliage plants or tropical's to create a beautiful arrangement that can quickly enhance your entryway, patio, or balcony.

When thinking about using annuals, make sure to consider their light needs. Sun loving annuals require at least 6-plus hours of sunlight a day. Shade loving annuals require 3 to 6-hours of sunlight per day.
