

Frost Danger Warnings

The average last frost date in this area ranges from May 11 -May 20. Low and open areas get the latest frosts. Higher more sheltered locations (protected by either a roof or trees) are less likely to be affected.

If you are looking for early season color, pansies are considered a cooler weather annual and can handle light frost. If you are looking to plant early season vegetables, consider using broccoli, brussels sprouts, cabbage, cauliflower, lettuce, and onions can tolerate a lot of frost.

If you plant vegetables or herbs like basil, cucumbers, eggplant, melon, squash, or tomatoes early, be prepared to cover them if you plant them outdoors before the last frost date. The same holds true for annuals like ageratum, begonias, coleus, dahlias, geraniums, impatiens, marigolds, salvia, and zinnias.
